On assessment of your complaint we have determined that it relates to your alleged abuse and torture, whilst being arrested by police officials. We further note that you have reported the case to the South African Police Service (SAPS), and that the matter is now handled by the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA).

In this regard, we advise that you continue to liaise with the NPA regarding the status of the matter. Alternatively, you may also lodge a complaint with the Independent Police Investigative Directorate (IPID) which is the institution that has been set up to deal with matters of this nature.
