

5.3 Malvern Cas 32/04/2007 Pinetown Lcrc 730/04/2007

On this crime scene's photos there are two bodies of African males with gunshot wounds. First body found in the vehicle (mini-bus) and wounds visible on the head. The second body lying on the floor between the wall and the vehicle (Audi) and one wound visible on the torso. The mini-bus had multiple entry bullet holes on the left side and back. The windows were shattered and on the photos it was not clear whether shots were fired from inside or outside. There was a firearm next to each body.


























FINDINGS:

The poor condition and sequence of the photos makes it difficult to give opinion of what could have transpired.

5.4 Phoenix Cas 377/08/2009 Durban Lcrc 622/08/2009.

On these crime scene photos I observed the body of an African male positioned on the drivers 'seat in a vehicle with gunshot wounds on the face, neck, head, right arm and right shoulder. A firearm was recovered in the vehicle next to the body.
