Thank you for your reply dated 17 December 2019

Let me remind you that :

-I have already issued a statement in 2016 via Mutual legal agreement ,after the NPA approached me for assistance ,multiple times ,as I had witnessed serious crimes committed via senior police officers while on duty with the Cato manor unit.
-I have yet to receive feedback, such as progress on the case , if still needed as a witness for the prosecution ,after I was interviewed multiple times in Greece ,at the S.African Embassy between 2012 -2016 and went through all the trouble to issue such MLA statement .
-I have furthermore provided hard evidence of torture ,tampering with evidence and extra judicial killings by senior police officers .Such evidence was officially handed over to a delegation of the NPA and Police investigators from S.Africa at the S.African Embassy in Greece.

As a recognised Whistle-blower and a Human rights activist in Europe ,I have suffered a great deal due to publication of fake news and a smeared campaign against my character in a clear attempt to be discredited as a witness. I therefore questioned your response and find it offensive the least ,since you are asking me “to liaise with the SAPS ,for any evidence of crimes committed “ after 7 years of placing my life on hold in order to do just that! It appears that your office is not committed or interested enough to bring justice to the families of those victims, that were tortured ,executed and had their human rights violated by the “untouchable “racist Cato manor officers in S.Africa! It is indeed a sad day for the S.African judicial system .
